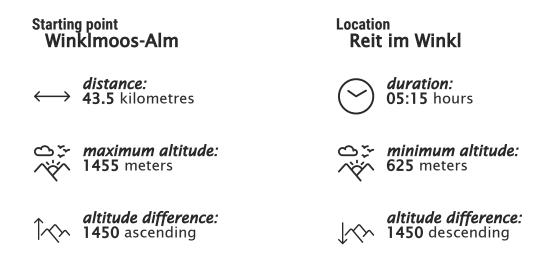


MTB 60 Loferer Alm Loop

TOUR

With almost 1500 meters of altitude one of the toughest MTB tours in the Chiemgau region. Please note the orientation text given in the description.



Highlights on the tour: pure nature, beautiful alpine pastures

From the Winklmoos-Alm you follow the signs to the Möseralm. Take the path to the valley stations of the chairlifts in the direction of Loferer Alm.

Then take the toll road towards Lofer. In Lofer you take the bike path towards Pass Strub to Waidring. Once there, follow the steep asphalt mountain road in the direction of Kammerköhr / Steinplatte.

At the car park, follow the road towards Stallenalm and over the Möseralm to the starting point in Winklmoos.

After crossing the border to Austria, orientate yourself on the signs. Furthermore, we recommend a navigation device (mobile phone, GPX device) and careful planning before the start of every tour!

Arrival by car

Coming from Munich or Salzburg on the motorway Munich - Salzburg (A8 to Grabenstätt exit no. 109), continue in the direction of Marquartstein and on the well-developed German Alpine Road (B305) to Reit im Winkl. At the entrance to the village (Entfelden) in the direction of Ruhpolding approx. 5 km to the Seegatterl district, then via the toll road from Seegatterl to the Winklmoos - Alm.

Parking: -Klammweg, 83242 Reit im Winkl.

Coming from Munich or Innsbruck on the federal motorway Rosenheim - Innsbruck (A93) to Oberaudorf (exit no. 59), on to Walchsee, Kössen and Reit im Winkl. Continue on the B 305 to

Ruhpolding approx. 5 km to the Seegatterl district, then via the toll road from Seegatterl to the Winklmoos - Alm.

Parking: -Klammweg, 83242 Reit im Winkl.

Arrival by public transport

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Prien am Chiemsee train station (best bus connection!). With the RVO bus line 9505.

Stop directly at the tourist information.

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Ruhpolding train station with the RVO line 9506.

Stop directly at the tourist information office.

Bicycles can be taken on the bus on a limited basis only.
