

Waterfall Walk

HIKING TOUR

A round tour to the waterfall, with great impressions and special features. An adventure for the whole family.

From the tourist information you head in the direction of the center past beautiful proud old farmhouses decorated with great flowers in the direction of our St. Pankratius church, with its imposing onion dome, built in the neo-baroque and art nouveau style.

The path continues through Hadergasse, as the locals affectionately call the Hausbergstraße. Here, too, you will find very old, partly restored, pretty houses. At the fork in the Hausbergstraße, we decide to go left and you can manage the short uphill stretch in no time at all, before immersing yourself in nature again. The narrow path meanders past the Pankratius spring, past rocks and a flowing stream to the waterfall, a landmark of our beautiful holiday resort.

Here at the latest you should dip your feet into the ice-cold mountain water that falls from the mountain and watch the brave climbers. Continue along the path past the Kriegerkapelle chapel, which was dedicated to the fallen soliders from Reit im Winkl of the two world wars. Via the Augustenruh (named after his nickname, Dr. August Oberweiler) it first goes to the Protestant Mountain Church, another special feature. It's easy to return to the starting point. ## Arrival by car

From Munich or Salzburg on the federal motorway Munich - Salzburg (A8 to Grabenstätt exit no. 109), continue towards Marquartstein and on the well-developed German Alpine Road (B 305) to Reit im Winkl. Parking:-Dorfstr. 38 at the Tourist Info, 83242 Reit im Winkl,-Tirolerstrasse 37 at the Festsaal, 83242 Reit im Winkl.

From Munich or Innsbruck on the federal motorway Rosenheim - Innsbruck (A93) to Oberaudorf (exit no. 59). Continue to Walchsee, Kössen and Reit im Winkl. Parking:-Tirolerstrasse 37 at the Festsaal, 83242 Reit im Winkl,-Tourist Info Dorfstrasse 38, 83242 Reit im Winkl.

## Arrival by public transport

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Prien am Chiemsee train station (best bus connection!). With the RVO bus line 9505. All timetables: www.reitimwinkl.de. Stop directly at the tourist information.

Connections to Reit im Winkl from Ruhpolding train station with the RVO line 9506. Stop directly at the Tourist Info.
